The superbly-appointed self-catering holiday cottages at White Lodge Farm are set in the heart of the beautiful Norfolk countryside, a short walk from the Conservation Area of the pretty village of Hingham, with its exceptional range of Georgian architecture.

The three cottages have been converted to a high standard with the more discerning visitor in mind and provide comfortable accommodation with central heating and a wide range of other modern amenities in traditional buildings.



The Barn and Dairy Cottage

We have sought to equip our cottages to give them a homely feel and so that guests will be left with the impression that we've thought of everything – certainly attention to detail is a phrase that crops up regularly in the visitors' books for the cottages.

The spacious accommodation in the **Barn** on the ground floor, which has no internal changes of level, comprises (all dimensions are approximate):

- Double bedroom (3.9m x 3.4m) (ample room for a cot) with en suite bathroom (2.3m x 1.7m)
- Double bedroom (3.7m x 3.1m)
- Twin bedroom (3.9m x 3.4m)
- Twin bedroom (3.7m x 3.1m)
- Family bathroom (2.3m x 2.1m)
- Family bathroom (2.6m x 1.9m) (with wheel-in shower)
- Kitchen area, dining area and sitting room area (10.8m x 5.9m)
- Utility room (3.3m x 1.8m)

and on the first floor:

- Double bedroom (3.5m x 3.4m) with en suite bathroom (2.3m x 1.9m)
- Double bedroom (5.0m x 2.7m) with ample room for a cot
- Bathroom (2.3m x 1.9m)
- Living room (8.5m x 5.9m).

Each bath has a shower over and each of the showers is supplied with hot and cold water under mains pressure.

The kitchen is well-equipped, with a dishwasher, washing machine, tumble dryer, range cooker, microwave and food-processor. We've also provided plenty of crockery, cutlery and glassware, not to mention pots, pans and utensils.

Those little extras

To save you having to bring some of those items overlooked in some self-catering accommodation, we provide:

Washing up liquid
Dishwasher powder and rinse aid
Washing powder
Fabric conditioner
Liquid soap
Some loo rolls
Some cling film
Shower gel/shampoo
for your use whilst staying with us at White Lodge Farm Cottages.

Dairy Cottage offers spacious accommodation on a single floor (with no internal changes of level) for a party of six in one twin and two double bedrooms, all with en suite access to their own bathroom. There's also room for a cot in each of the double bedrooms.

Stable Cottage has two double bedrooms (one of them en suite), a twin bedroom and a further bathroom. A galleried area above the kitchen also has a single futon.

Our tariff (which is available on our website) includes use of bedding* and linen, including table linen, central heating, electricity, gas (for cooking) and a welcome pack (see box).

*For hygiene reasons, guests are asked to bring mattresses and linen for cots.

Norfolk offers so many things to see and do, it's hard to know what to pick out – there's the historic city of Norwich, the Norfolk Broads, Thetford Forest, the unique Breckland landscape, and around 100 miles of varied and unique coastline, all of them within an hour's drive or less of White Lodge Farm. Arrive and relax!

When you arrive at White Lodge Farm you'll find parking close to your cottage. You'll also find the beds made and towels laid out for your party. A tray for you to make a welcoming tea or coffee with our compliments will also await.

All our cottages are strictly non-smoking. Each has its own garden and there is ample parking. Our normal changeover day is Friday. A significant proportion of our guests stay for a weekend (3 nights Friday to Monday) or midweek (4 nights Monday to Friday). Many guests come to celebrate a birthday, wedding anniversary or other family occasion. But the cottages are just as suitable for use as a base to explore the beautiful Norfolk countryside or to relax in comfort.
